

Short Tutorial for Vilja's Wardrobe System

(powered by Amgepo)

for further instructions refer to the manual

Outfits

A freely configurable set of clothing OR armor which Vilja will wear on the player's request

Wardrobe

A freely configurable choice of clothing AND armor which can either be

1. automatically equipped or
2. worn on the player's request

Compose an Outfit

"Regarding your outfit...\Let's select your various outfits\Let's look at your outfits...\Outfit A"

- Wait some seconds and click on ONE item for EACH body region which you want Vilja to equip.
 1. For the head click on a circlet, hat or helmet
 2. For the neck click on an amulet or necklace
 3. For the body click on a dress or an armor
 4. For the hands and lower arms click on gloves, bracers or gauntlets
 5. For the fingers click on a ring
 6. For the feet and lower legs click on boots or shoes

If you don't assign anything, Vilja will of course be naked. If you only assign an amulet, she will be just naked with an amulet.

- Tab-out of the clothing list.
- Do this for all the Outfits A – E, the Swimming and Sleeping Outfit if you like.

Equip the Outfit

"Regarding your outfit...\Wear Outfit A"

Unequip the Outfits

"Regarding your outfit...\Wear whatever you like (default – no wardrobes)"

If you have already set up wardrobes you can switch to Autochange wardrobes again with:

"Regarding your outfit...\Wear your wardrobes (autochange)"

Compose a Wardrobe of Your Choice and For Specific Occasions

(Wardrobes can be worn by Vilja either on request or with changing them automatically dependent on specific occasions.)

"Regarding your outfit...\Let's select your various outfits\Let's look at your wardrobes..."

- In the messagebox click for example on **"Elegant"** to set up the clothing Vilja should wear if she is joining you to the Jarl's Longhouse, a palace or a castle.
- In the default setting Vilja will only equip the Elegant Wardrobe if she is asked to do so. Click **"Autochange"** if Vilja should equip the Elegant Wardrobe automatically when it is appropriate. Afterwards you can still revert to the default setting (click on **"No – Autochange"**).
- Click on **"Combat"** if Vilja should equip your choice of garment in combat. Afterwards you can still revert to the default setting **"Non-Combat"**.
- Finally click on **"Contents"** and you get the clothing list as explained before for outfits and you can now assign both, clothing parts for non-combat use, and armor parts for combat use

Equip the Wardrobe on Request

"Regarding your outfit...\Wear your elegant wardrobe"
